In these examples, I will use the standard of abbreviating a Ctrl key combination as *C-x*, where *x* is the second key (pressed simultaneously). A space between key sequences indicates that they are pressed in order.

Starting/Resuming screen

Resume screen session screen -r [PID]
Start a new (named) session screen -S [name]
Resume a named session screen -r [name]

Start a named screen session with an initially running command, then detach it:

screen -S ekg_session -md [command] &

Leaving Screen

Exit screen *C-d*

Exit screen, leaving attached processed running in background

C-a d

Utility Commands

List detached sessions screen -list

Tabs

Create a new tab C-a c

Change title of active tab *C-a A* and enter name

Create a new tab and start running a program in it (tab gets program's name)

C-a: screen [program name]

Next tab C-a nPrevious tab C-a pList all tabs, to select one C-a "

Resize a tab *C-a: resize [size]* where size is the height in lines

Regions

Split screen into two regions *C-a S*

Switch regions *C-a [tab]* (then *C-a c* to create a shell in an unused region)
